

Zonta recognizes leading women

That’s what Zonta Club of Beloit membership chair Marcy Reedy said at the club’s 39th Annual Tribute to Women banquet held Tuesday evening at the Garden Hotel and Conference Center in South Beloit.

The event recognized outstanding women and featured an enchanted evening with music by cellist Hannah Filipiak, raffle items, dinner, recognition of past award winners and more.

Mistress of Ceremonies Monica Krysztopa kicked off the occasion with some inspiring quotes, including Oprah Winfrey’s words that "The biggest adventure you can take is to live the life of your dreams."
